Its aim is to frame the topic of the influence of Old Church Slavonic on Old Czech, dealt with in the current grant project of our Department (GAČR No. 18-02702S), in a broader context of the influence of (Old) Church Slavonic on the Slavonic and other languages. Languages of the contribution: all Slavonic languages, English, German, French.

Written versions of the contributions, provided they are accepted during an anonymous review process, will be published in a conference proceedings within the series *Studia etymologica Brunensia*. The language of the paper – accompanied by an abstract in English and by a summary in a Slavonic language – will be English, Russian, German or French.
