The programme will include oral presentations, a poster session, a linguistics careers panel session, and a plenary talk.

Abstracts not accepted for oral presentation will automatically be considered for poster presentation. Presenters will be invited to contribute extended abstracts to the *Oxford Working Papers in Linguistics*.
